Re: Street closure / parking prohibited
Washington Avenue (between West Broadway & Fifth Avenue)

Dear Resident,

On **Tuesday & Wednesday February 12th & 13th** a portion of Washington Avenue (between West Broadway & Fifth Avenue) will be closed for the erection of a pre-fabricated home at 345 Washington Avenue. **Street parking will be prohibited between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm both days.** The No-Parking period may be extended based on field conditions.

Although every effort will be made to allow residents to leave and return to their driveways, at times during the day access in and out of your property might be restricted. Traffic flag-men will be present to safely direct traffic as needed, and their directions should be followed for everyone's safety.

If your child is transported to school by Independent Coach, arrangements have been made for pick up and drop off on the corner of Washington & Fifth Avenue at the regularly schedule times. We have not been able to identify the other private bus companies and if your child's school does not use Independent Coach, please contact the School's transportation office to make appropriate arrangements.

All emergency services, including the NC Police Department, Lawrence-Cedarhurst Fire Department, and Hatzalah Ambulance will be notified.
