By a letter dated May 17, 2019, the Long Island Rail Road (LIRR) requested a hearing to consider modifications to the above-referenced public at-grade rail crossing to address the Village's conversion of a two-way street to a one-way street over the crossing. This hearing was held, and a temporary modification was approved. The hearing record was left open to accommodate the future proposal of a permanent modification. By letter dated May 22, 2023, LIRR submitted a request for a second hearing to consider the permanent modification. 




