Village Clerk-Treasurer Plaut took roll call, everyone present.

On motion of Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Wasser, the following reports for the month of January 2026 were unanimously accepted:

On motion of Trustee Wasser, seconded by Trustee Zisman, payment was approved of all properly audited vouchers, except as noted as per the Board Audit dated February 2, 2026, covering vouchers from January 7, 2025, through February 2, 2026.

On motion of Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Zisman, the Board Meeting Minutes of January 6, 2026, were adopted.

The Village Clerk-Treasurer presented the certified bid tabulation for Streetlight Maintenance Services (Bid No. TI-2026-001), reflecting the bids received and publicly opened on January 14, 2026.

Upon motion duly made by Mayor Weinstock and seconded by Trustee Brown, the Board of Trustees reviewed and accepted the certified bid tabulation as submitted by the Village Clerk-Treasurer and adopted a resolution awarding the contract to Welsbach Electric Corp. of Long Island, having been determined to be the lowest responsible bidder in the best interest of the Village.

The Mayor was authorized to execute the contract, and the Village Clerk-Treasurer was authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the award.

Trustee Plaut and Trustee Wasser presented a citation to Lawrence-Cedarhurst Firefighter Robert Hicks who was injured while fighting a fire on December 20, 2025. Bobby was honored for his courage and heroism by the Village of Cedarhurst.
