TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Bid Packet, as noted below. All bidders must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their bid submission.

Except as modified herein, all other terms and conditions of the Bid Documents shall remain unchanged.

1. CLARIFICATIONS

A. Design / Color Layout

There is no preapproved design included in the bid documents.

Bidders shall base their pricing on a two-color installation consisting of approximately fifty percent (50%) primary color and fifty percent (50%) secondary color within the wear layer.

Final layout, color selection, and any pattern configuration shall be determined by the Village prior to installation.

No additional compensation shall be provided for a standard two-color layout. Any specialty graphics or complex custom designs requested by the Village shall be addressed by change order.

B. Surface Edging

The Village acknowledges that the existing poured-in-place surfacing transitions into adjacent landscaped areas.

Bidders shall base their pricing on installation with a rolled (feathered) edge condition, consistent with existing conditions.

Contractors shall verify all edge conditions in the field. If the Village directs an alternative edge treatment (e.g., containment curb or other defined edge), such work shall be addressed as a change order.

2. ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Bidders must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their bid submission by completing and submitting the Addendum Acknowledgment Form.
